

Scream Silence

Band Biography

Scream Silence, founded 1998 are one of the most popular gothic rock bands in Germany since they released their debut album "TO DIE FOR" in 1999, after it earned many prizes and honours like "the album of the month" on popular scene magazines like "ORKUS". Longer support tours were followed with the "Christian Death" and the "Dreadful Shadows" and after the splitting of the "Shadows", Scream Silence was called for long as their successor from the press.

With the release of the next album, the band around mastermind Hardy Fieting showed that they would not rest on their first fame. "THE 2nd" (2001) was called a "milestone of the gothic rock for the next century" from many reviewers, and climbed the charts in Germany and mostly in many East European countries. So the band toured as headliner across the country this time and played on festivals like "The Wave Gotik Treffen" in Leipzig in front of more than 8000 fans.

After the guys on bass and guitar (Rene and Joerg) were leaving the band in 2002, Scream Silence gathered fresh blood with their old friends from the local heroes "Scroon". Together with Robert on the guitar and Cornel on the bass the band released in spring 2003 "SEVEN TEARS" their most unique work so far. And again the reviewers and fans were touched to more than seven tears and the album earned the "album of the month" on the biggest dark magazine in Germany called "ZILLO" and gets highest reviewer points on other magazines (ORKUS 10/10). Although the small label moonstorm in the cause of financial problems wasn't able for making a real promotion for the album (no advertisements etc.) at that time, "SEVEN TEARS" were sold near the double of the predecessor.

The next highlight was a special concert on the "Herbstnächte (autumn nights) festival" where Adam Pearson from the Sisters of Mercy were the guest on stage and played together with Scream Silence some of their songs. And also the band were accompanied from a female string duet to give the songs an more elegical touch. november 2004 . First pre reviews are talking of "The frofound masterpiece of these unique band". The single "Curious Changes" will released a few weeks before and for the first time the band has made a video clip which will be included on the single. In autumn 2004 the band is planning to tour across Europe, and with your help also in your near....
